

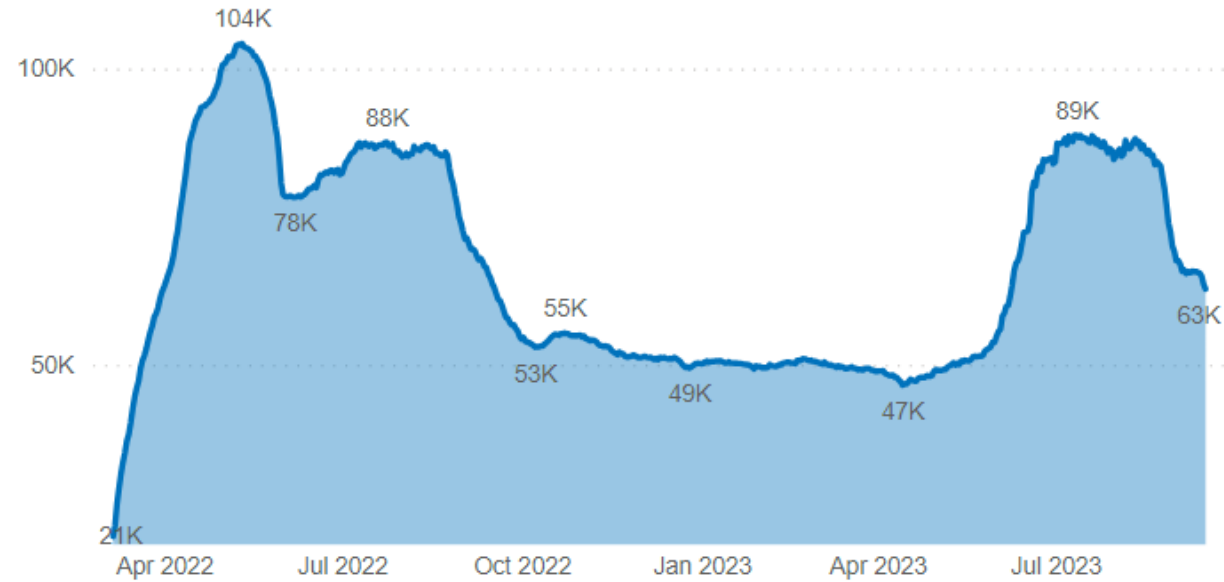


Bulgarian country context

- **55,153** Ukrainian's residing in Bulgaria with TPS.
- **12,067** people are currently being supported in Gov't.
- Significant increase of Ukrainians residing in Bulgaria since June 2023
- Access to **health services & MHPSS** needs have been identified as a priority by Ukrainians.
- Bulgarian RC are the main implementing partner for UNHCR, UNICEF & IFRC funds (+others)

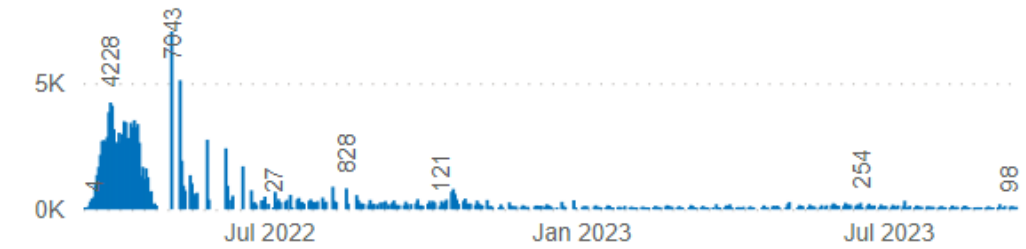

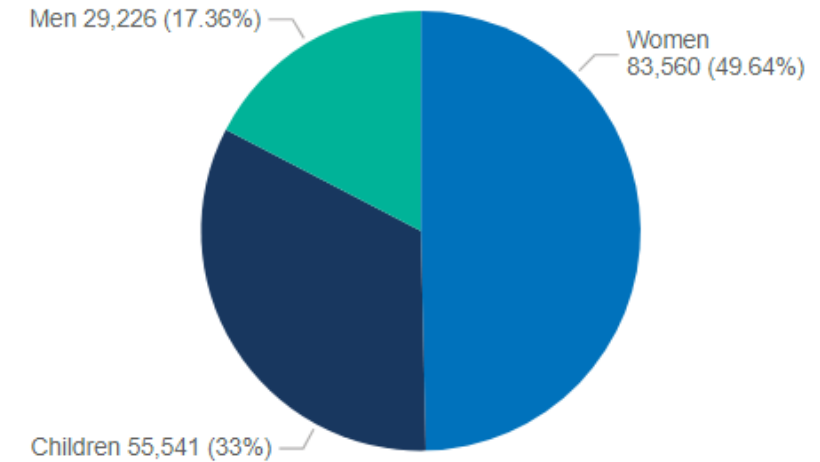

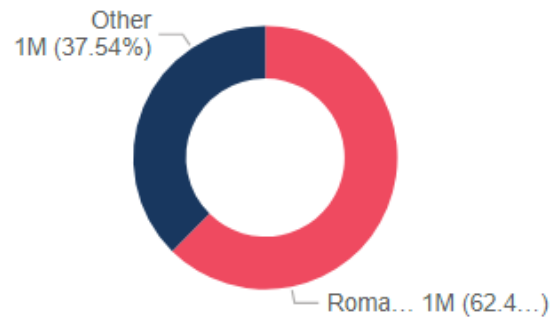
Temporary Protection registrations by date



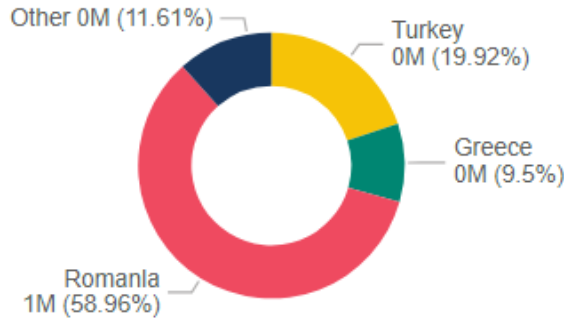
TP Age & Gender

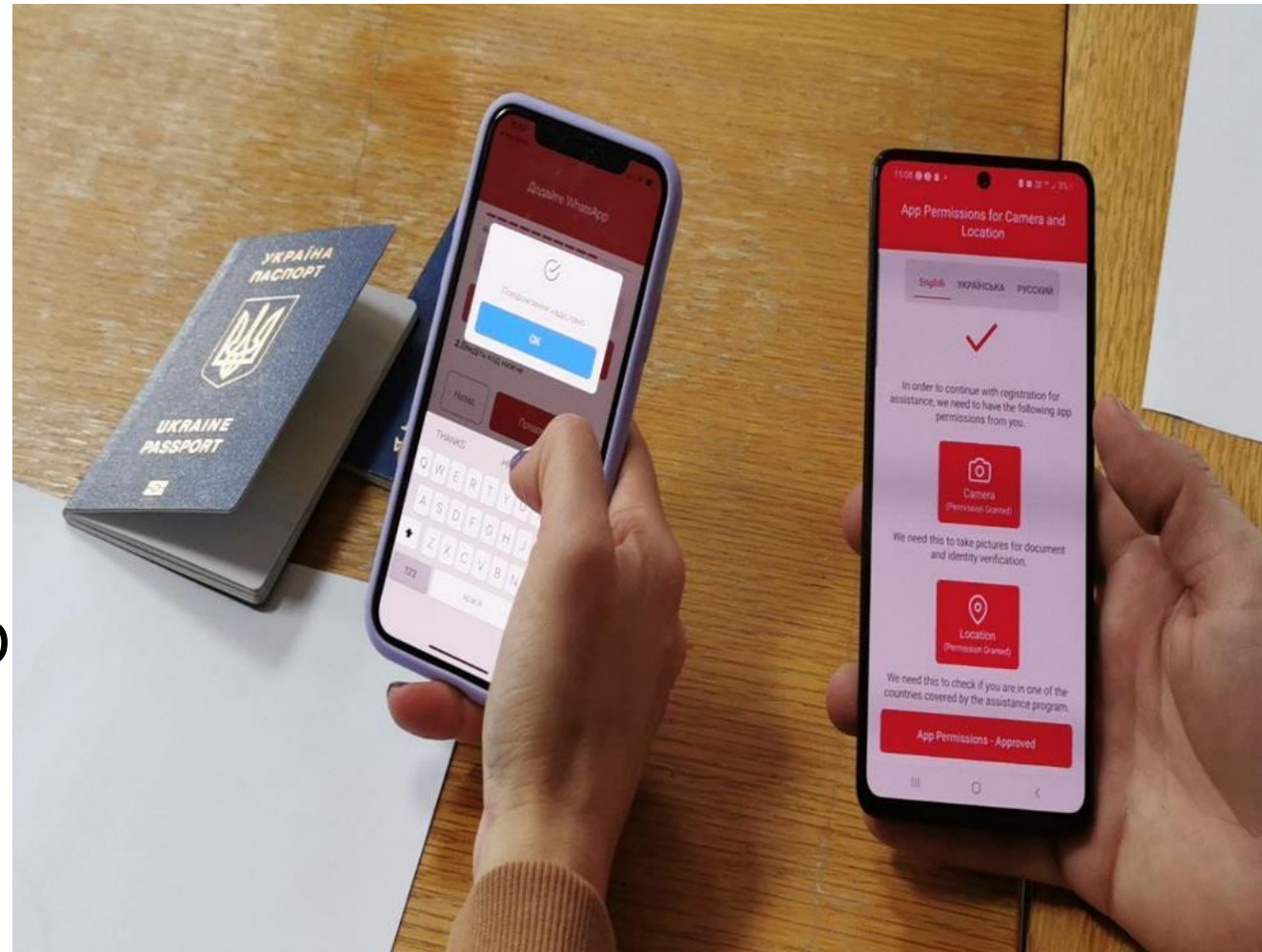

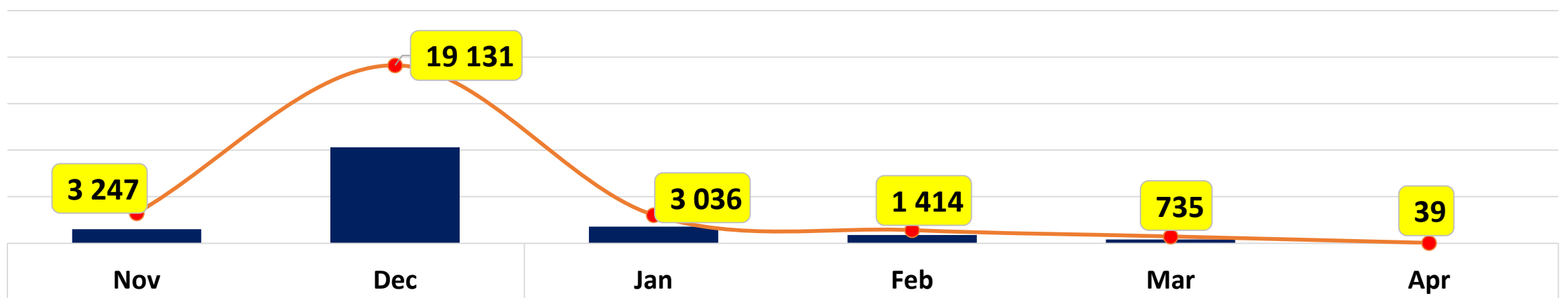




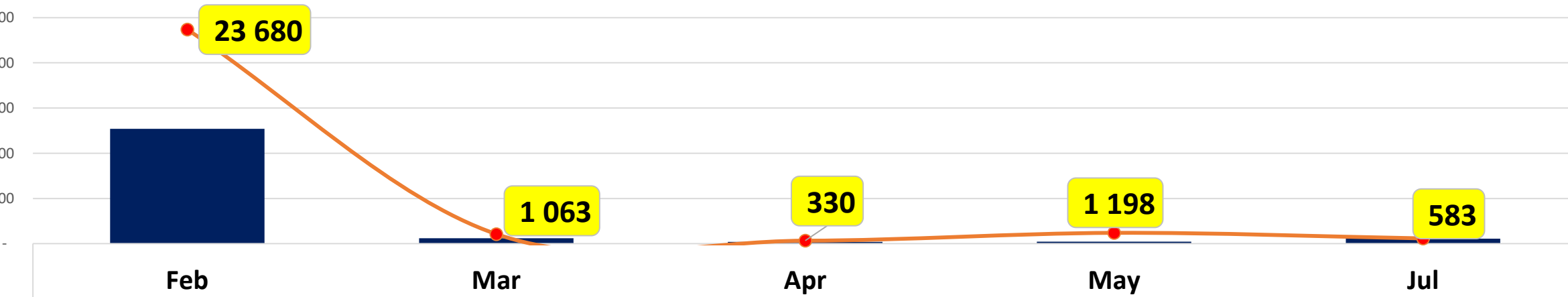
Registration timeline for MPCG (UKR)



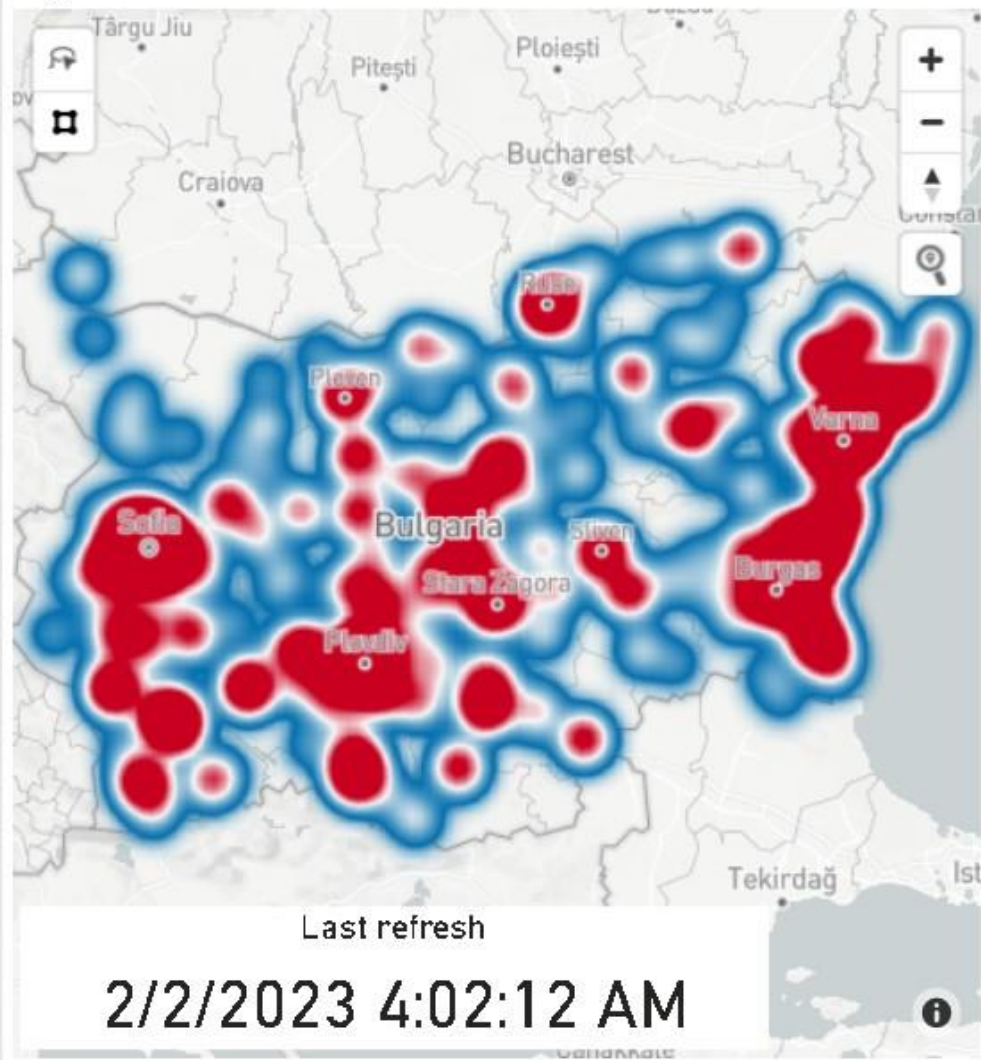
1st Phase of MPC grants

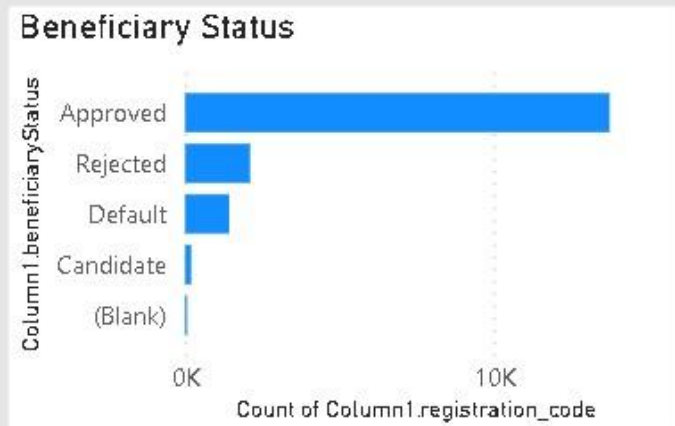

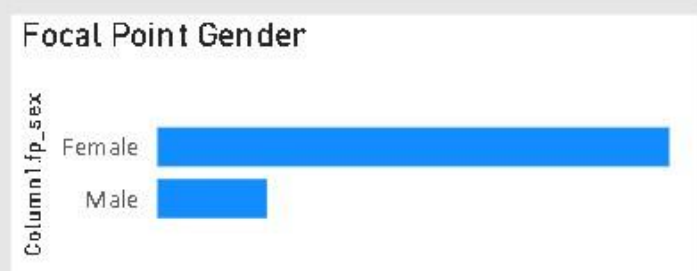

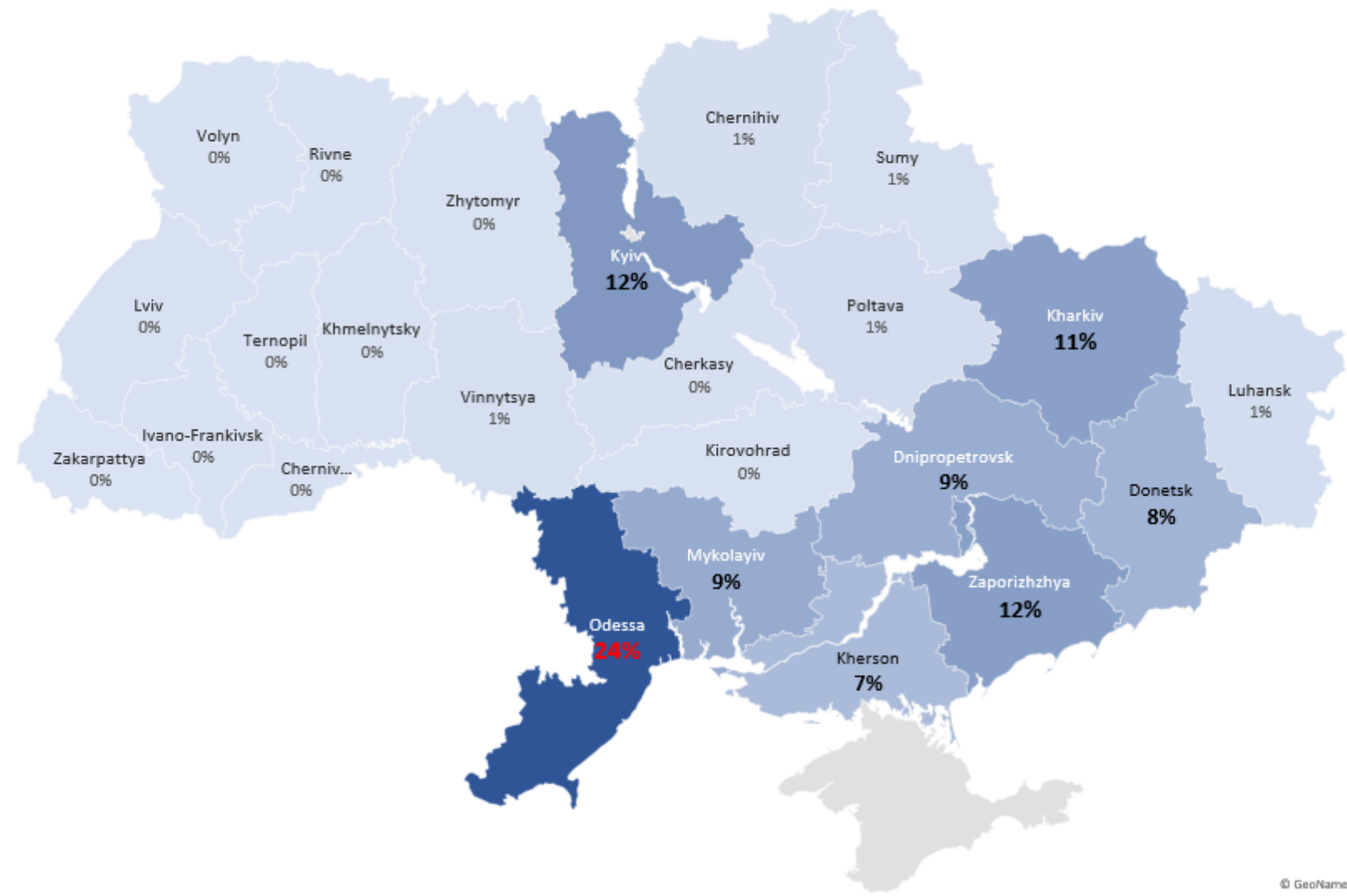


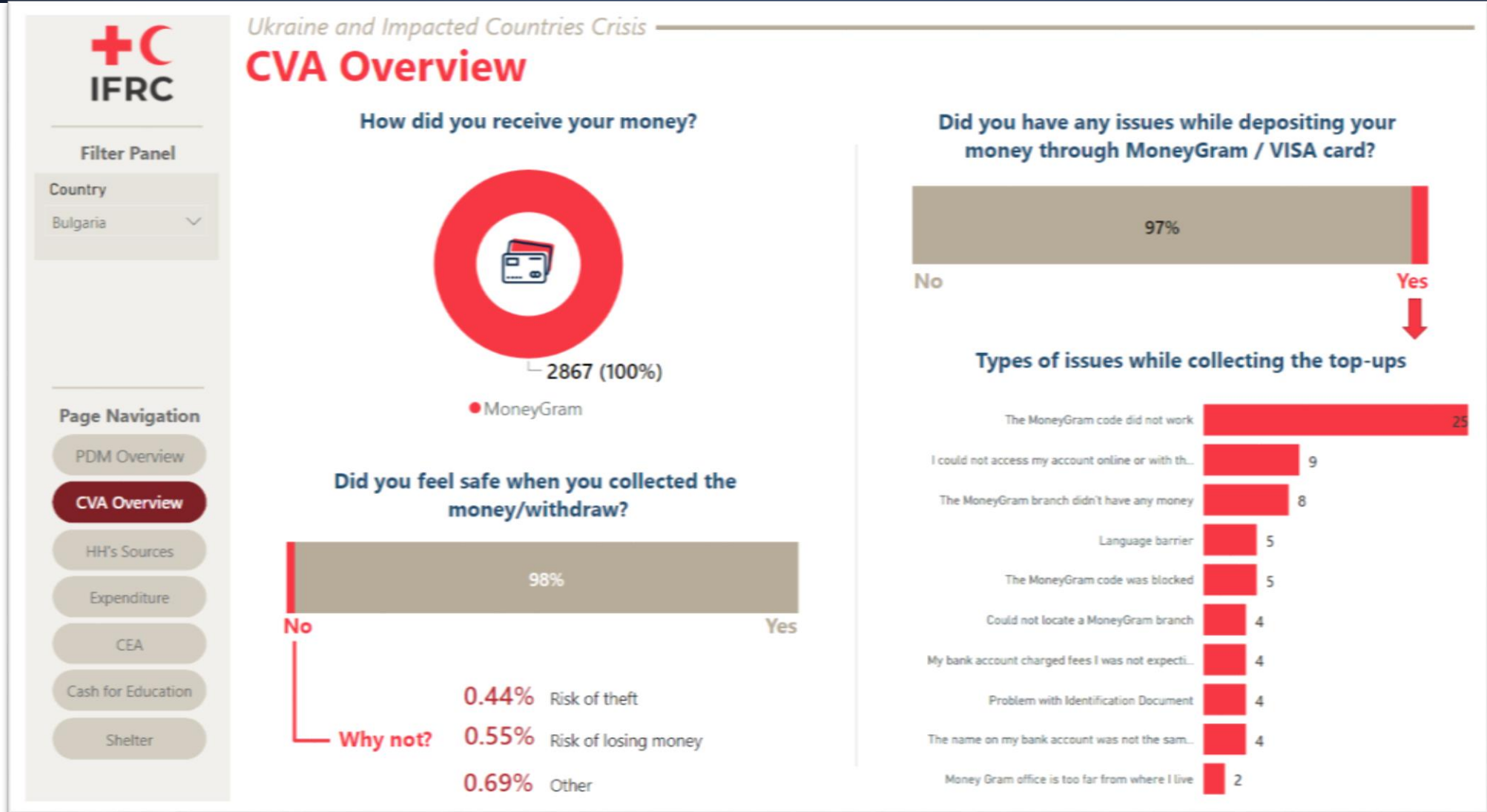


Ukrainian displacement data

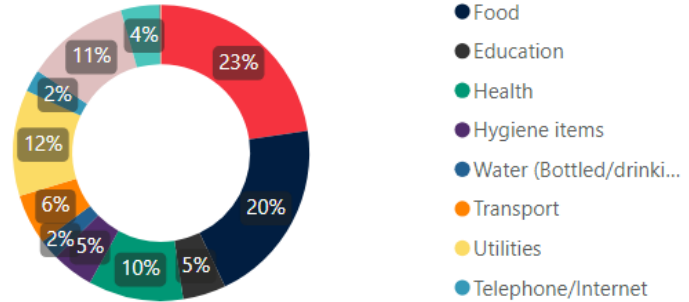

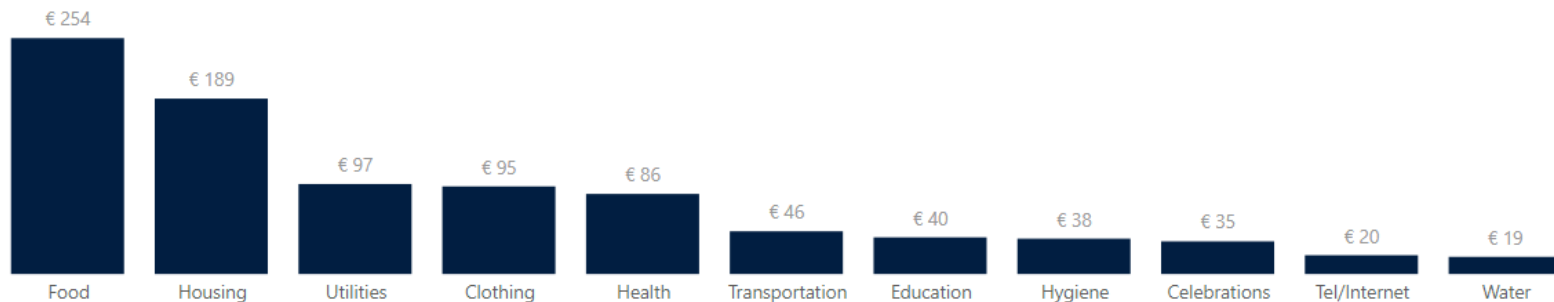

Country	Total amount of debt (€)	Average debt per Household (€)
Bulgaria	€ 1,480K	€ 1,761
Romania	€ 657K	€ 1,458
Moldova	€ 536K	€ 481
Slovakia	€ 327K	€ 2,389
Hungary	€ 125K	€ 822
Montenegro	€ 56K	€ 1,649

- Households were identified in collaboration with the Ministry of Social Affairs
- Reliance on self registration app for the most vulnerable is not advisable.
- BRC established a system which allowed volunteers to visit each identified household.
- Anecdotal evidence points to vulnerable Ukrainian HHs receiving support to use the digital platforms.





Moving forward



- New Access RC app – linked to all support services
- Improved information for program design through updated Needs Assessment and PDMs
- Cash Preparedness process for Bulgarian RC (framework agreement with FSPs, SoPs etc)
- Expand Cash 4 Health through 2024
- MPC grants for highly vulnerable “new” arrivals – if funding permits
